Getting Started

Volunteering and having a positive impact on your community is really about helping someone else. Look around you. Is there an older neighbor that would like your company or could use some help around the house? Are there younger kids in your neighborhood that you could help with school work or teach a new game or skill? Decide what you would like to do to help someone else and see who you can get involved to make it happen. Clean up activities are another important way you can make a difference. Talk to your teacher about a special clean up project you would like to do for your school. Volunteering often starts with a church or scout community activity. If you are not a member of club or group consider joining one.

If you are under age 10, you will probably need to volunteer with a group or ask a parent or grandparent to volunteer with you. You will learn a lot and it will be a rewarding activity to do with a special adult or family member. Below are some other possibilities.
