What is the Hanover Youth Service Council?

The Hanover Youth Service Council (HYSC) is a youth-led countywide organization that consists of 35 middle and high school students selected for their dedication to service and leadership. HYSC members promote service and address needs within Hanover County and beyond by planning and conducting various monthly service projects (issue areas include: animal welfare, seniors, the environment, community building, at-risk youth and more). Since its beginning in 1998, HYSC members have volunteered more than 5,100 hours in the community.

Who can apply for the Hanover Youth Service Council?

Are you interested in creating change, serving your community and inspiring others through volunteerism? Any youth, who is a rising 7th grader through 12th grader, who currently resides in Hanover County and/or attends a Hanover school is eligible to apply.

How much of a commitment is the Hanover Youth Service Council?

It is a privilege to serve on HYSC and the responsibility is not to be taken lightly. Members are expected to attend at least 67% of meetings *and* projects. In addition to scheduled service projects (there is at least one project per month), HYSC meets monthly to discuss, plan and coordinate upcoming projects. HYSC meetings are scheduled the first Wednesday of each month from 7:30-8:30 p.m.

If invited to proceed to the second round of the membership process, all prospective candidates will be **required** to attend the following Group Interview/Information Meeting. Please make note of these dates when determining your ability to participate on the council.

 - c. What strengths or talents did you share or develop?
3. Why do you want to be a member of HYSC?

4. Without being humble, what do you value most about yourself as a family member, friend, student, citizen and so on? (*i.e. What are your best qualities?*)
5. What causes do you feel most passionate about and why? (*Examples: animal welfare, poverty, literacy, the arts, etc. There are no wrong answers.*)
6. Do you have any suggestions for new HYSC projects or partnerships? What are some ideas in how HYSC can make a bigger impact on the community?

Letters of Recommendation

Each applicant must provide two (2) letters of recommendation with their application. These recommendation letters can come from any ADULT, other than a relative, who has worked with the applicant on a one-on-one basis. Applicants are responsible for including the recommendation letters in the application packet or ensuring letters are received by the recommenders in a timely manner.
