

Industrial Development Authority

DESCRIPTION

The Hanover County Industrial Development Authority (IDA) consists of seven members appointed by their respective Board member from each magisterial district in the County. The IDA was created by an ordinance adopted by the Board of Supervisors on August 30, 1967 and is a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Virginia, but has no taxing authority. The IDA is empowered to, among other things, acquire, construct, improve, maintain, equip, own, lease, and dispose of various types of facilities, including facilities for use by the County, and to finance the same by issuance of revenue bonds. Though the powers of the IDA are legislatively broad, Hanover's IDA has primarily been used for the purpose of considering industrial revenue bond requests and assisting the County in lease revenue bonds.

Revenues are received principally from inducement resolutions approved by the IDA. The County collects a management fee of 1/10 of 1% of all outstanding debt issued after 1996.
