**Superintendent James C. Willett, CJM earns second National Certification**

For Immediate Release: Colonel James C. Willett, CJM, Superintendent of the Pamunkey Regional Jail in Hanover, Virginia has earned the Certified Corrections Manager, (CCM) designation from the American Correctional Association. Superintendent Willett is currently the only Virginia jail Superintendent and one of just 147 corrections professionals nationwide to have achieved this designation.

Prior to certification, applicants must qualify on the basis of their experience and qualifications in the field of corrections, as well as successfully complete an intensive written examination concerning their knowledge as a Corrections Manager.

The CCM designation is an indication of demonstrated professionalism involving such activities as managing human resources, enhancing the institutional environment, managing a department, developing and maintaining expertise, and general knowledge concerning the field of corrections.

Superintendent Willett has over 11 years of experience in the Criminal Justice field. In October of 2007, he completed his first full year as the jail's Superintendent.

Superintendent Willett is a member of the American Correctional Association (ACA), American Jail Association (AJA), and the Virginia Association of Regional Jails (VARJ). He has completed the certificate program offered by the Public Safety Institute at Virginia Commonwealth University, and has also completed extensive instruction on Executive Leadership-Upper Level Management Training, and Public Safety's Response to Terrorism.
