Captain Mary N. White Awarded National Certification

For Immediate Release: Captain Mary N. White has received the national designation of Certified Jail Manager, (CJM) through the Jail Manager Certification Commission, by authority of the American Jail Association (AJA). Captain White is one of just 360 jail professionals nation-wide to have achieved this designation.

This certification has been achieved through the successful completion of a rigid experiential background application, and an intensive written examination prepared by the Commission and the American Jail Association.

Certification in jail management is a demonstration of competency and professionalism in the field. The Jail Manager's certification documents the mastery of a strong level of knowledge in the specialty, and demonstrates continuing education and growth.

Since being hired by the Pamunkey Regional Jail in July, 1997, Capt. White has served in many of the jail's areas, including Support Services, Operations, Administration, and Internal Affairs. Currently, Capt. White is the Division Commander of the Support Services section, which includes staff training, inmate programs, inmate hearings, commissary, inmate mail, visitation, road crew (trash pickup), work force, work release, and the jail accreditation and inspections.

Captain White has over 32 years of correctional experience and is a member of the American Correctional Association (ACA), the American Jail Association and the Correctional Accreditation Managers Association (CAMA). She holds an Associate's Degree in criminal justice.
