On August 7, 2004, Sheriff's Deputies investigated a traffic crash on Mechanicsville Turnpike approximately one-quarter mile east of Creighton Parkway. Upon their arrival they discovered a two-vehicle collision involving a 2002 Ford Mustang and a 2002 Pontiac Sunfire coupe. The occupants of the Pontiac were declared deceased at the scene and a passenger in the Ford received serious injuries.

The investigation revealed that the Pontiac was being driven by Lisa Marie Magruder of the 100 block of Gateway East in Richmond, and her passenger was David Michael King of the 1100 block of Westbriar Drive also from Richmond. Both were killed instantly when their vehicle was struck by the Ford Mustang traveling east on Rt. 360.

As a result the investigation into this crash, the driver of the Mustang, a 17 year old Mechanicsville teenager, has been charged with two counts of involuntary manslaughter. Involuntary manslaughter is a class five felony. The case will be heard in Hanover County Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court. Due to his age, the juvenile's name will not be released.
