The Sheriff's Office is sad to report that a 17-year-old male was killed as a result of a vehicle accident.

On Saturday, July 30, 2005, at approximately 6:42 p.m. Sheriff's deputies responded to a single vehicle crash on Teman Road approximately .6 miles north of Coatesville Road. The preliminary investigation indicates that a 1997 Subaru Legacy was traveling north on Teman Road when the vehicle ran off the right shoulder and lost control causing the vehicle to run off the right shoulder a second time and impact a tree.

Emergency medical personnel declared the driver, a 17-year-old male from Beaverdam, identified as Matthew C. Bauserman, deceased at the scene. The driver was traveling alone in the vehicle, and it appears that he was wearing his seat belt at the time of the collision.

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office Traffic Safety Team is continuing to investigate this accident to determine the cause and exact chain of events leading to this tragedy. We ask the community to keep the family and friends in their thoughts and prayers with as they cope with the loss of their loved one.
