Today, February 7, 2006, at approximately 1:00 p.m. the Hanover County Sheriff's Office responded to **BB & T Bank**, located at 7016 Mechanicsville Turnpike, in reference to a **robbery**.

A black male suspect approached the teller and passed a note demanding US currency. No weapon was displayed. The suspect obtained an undisclosed amount of US currency. There were no injuries.

The suspect is described as a black male with medium complexion and a goatee, 20 to 30 years of age, approximately 6'0 tall and weighting 220 to 240 lbs. The suspect was wearing a black jacket, light colored shirt, **light colored sweat pants with two red stripes on the sides**, eyeglasses with tinted lenses, and a black stocking cap.

Witnesses observed the suspect traveling west on Mechanicsville Turnpike in vehicle described as a large four-door sedan, bluish green in color. **The vehicle is similar to a mid 80's Ford Thunderbird or Lincoln Mercury.**
