

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office is seeking the community's assistance in identifying a suspect involved in a bank robbery today at the Bank of America located in Mechanicsville.

Today, at approximately 9:45 a.m. a black female entered the Bank of America, located at 6563 Mechanicsville Turnpike, and robbed the teller of an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency after passing a note and demanding money. Fortunately, a weapon was not used in this incident and no one was injured.

The suspect was last seen leaving the bank lobby carrying a dark colored bag or backpack walking towards the rear of the building. The suspect is described as a black female, 40-50 years of age, 130-150 pounds, 5'3"-5'6", with brown eyes and black hair. The suspect was last seen wearing dark tight-fitting jeans, dark colored work boots, and a dark colored hooded sweatshirt underneath a flannel shirt.

The Sheriff's Office continues to investigate all possible leads in this case and will work closely with the community to bring this investigation to a successful conclusion.
