The C&F Bank, located at 7021 Mechanicsville Turnpike, was robbed this morning at 9:00 a.m., just after opening.

The suspect was the first person to enter the bank, right after the employees opened at 9:00 a.m. Upon entering, he immediately approached the teller station, displayed a handgun, and directed the tellers to fill a plastic bag with currency. While the tellers were attempting to comply with his demands, the suspect jumped over the counter and became more aggressive. After obtaining an undisclosed amount of currency the suspect directed the employees into the lobby and then left out the front door. He was last seen crossing Mechanicsville Turnpike traveling on foot in the area of Sujen Court.

The suspect, described as a dark skinned black male, clean shaven, approximately 6'0" tall and 200 lbs., he was wearing work type cloths described as a dark blue short sleeve shirt with similar colored pants. He also had a black baseball style cap and black sunglasses.
