

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office needs assistance in identifying those responsible in the robbery of the EVB Bank in Mechanicsville.

Today at approximately 11:37 a.m. two black males entered the EVB Bank (formerly Hanover Bank), located at 8071 Mechanicsville Turnpike, armed with handguns and robbed the tellers of an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency.

When the suspects entered the bank, one went behind the counter to access the teller drawers while the other displayed a handgun and directed the bank employees. At the time of the robbery, there were five employees and one customer in the bank and fortunately no one was injured.

The suspects were last seen on foot entering a wooded area across the street from the EVB bank.

The suspects are described as young black males, possibly 18-25 years of age, of average height and weight. One suspect wore a blue hooded jacket with light colored hood strings and sunglasses. The other suspect wore a baseball style cap with a camouflage design, sunglasses, and dark colored jacket.

Investigators continue to gather and process information and evidence related to this incident. Additional information will be provided as the investigation progresses.
