Investigators Make Arrest in M & T Bank Robbery

In a coordinated effort involving multiple jurisdictions, Joel W. Galindo was recently arrested in the City of Richmond by the U.S. Marshal's Capital Region Fugitive Task Force on outstanding warrants from the Hanover County Sheriff's Office for the May 19, 2011, robbery of the M&T Bank on Atlee Road.

Galindo, 25, of the 100 block of Mildres Ave. in Williamsburg was also linked to bank robberies in Fredrick, Maryland; Henrico County; James City County; Chesterfield County; and the City of Richmond.

On May 19, 2011, Galindo walked into the M&T Bank at 8206 Atlee Road in Hanover County wearing a fake mustache and presented a note demanding money from the teller. Galindo then fled the bank and was seen leaving in a black pickup truck.

Galindo was charged in Hanover County with Robbery and Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony. Galindo was also charged in Richmond; James City County; and Frederick, Maryland. Charges are pending in Chesterfield and Henrico Counties. He is currently being held at the Pamunkey Regional Jail without bond.
