

Arrests Made in Series of Larceny from Vehicle Incidents

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office recently arrested Thomas J. Globig, 20, of the 9300 block of Crossover Drive in Hanover County on 21 larceny charges, 1 arson, and 3 credit card charges related to larcenies from vehicles. These incidents occurred between February and August 2009 in neighborhoods throughout the central area of the county.

Larcenies in neighborhoods such as Ashland Heights, Cedarlea, Atlee Ridge, Grand Hickory, and Fox Head have been linked to Globig.

Globig was identified as a possible suspect in larceny from vehicle cases and was subsequently observed entering several unlocked vehicles in Henrico County in the early morning hours of August 15, 2009 by Hanover County Sheriff's Office Investigators. Globig was then stopped in the area of Chamberlayne Road at the Henrico-Hanover County line. The ongoing investigation has lead to the aforementioned charges. Other charges in Henrico County are also pending.
