

### **Two Arrests Made in Wachovia Bank Robbery**

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a robbery at Wachovia Bank, located at 7085 Mechanicsville Turnpike at approximately 1:30 p.m. on June 16, 2009. The responding officers determined that a black male entered the bank and used threatening language while demanding US currency. They were also able to quickly assemble witness information and disseminate that information to area law enforcement agencies. Henrico Police subsequently initiated a traffic stop in eastern Henrico County based on the information provided and subsequently detained two individuals. Investigators determined that these two individuals were responsible for the robbery.

Antonio V. Gary a 47-year-old black male of the 300 block of Washington Court in Highland Springs and Marvin M. Clark a 44 year old black male of the 3000 block of Emporia Street in Richmond have been charged with robbery and conspiracy to commit robbery. They are currently incarcerated in Pamunkey Regional Jail awaiting arraignment.

"This quick apprehension was attributed to accurate witness information, quick response by our Deputies, and outstanding cooperation on behalf of Henrico Police," said Colonel V. Stuart Cook, Sheriff of Hanover County.
