Citizens Quick Actions Nabs Two Larceny Suspects

The Sheriff's Office has received a number of calls from media and citizens regarding an increased presence of patrol vehicles in the area of the Rutland community on Rt. 301 yesterday around noon.

At that time the Sheriff's Office was responding to the Rutland Kroger, 9351 Atlee Road, in reference to a black male that had taken a purse from the shopping cart of a Kroger customer. The suspect, later identified as Brian Davis, 20, fled the store on foot while being pursued by Kroger employees who had been alerted about the theft.

The employees continued to chase Brian Davis through the parking lot and into the adjacent Rutland neighborhood. During the chase, Davis, ultimately discarded the purse and ran full circle back to the Kroger parking lot, where he was seen getting into a vehicle. That vehicle was stopped by the Sheriff's Office at Rt. 301 and Atlee Station Road. Brian Davis was taken into custody at that time. Driving the vehicle was Quinn Davis, 25.

Both Bryan Davis and Quinn Davis were charged with grand larceny and conspiracy to commit grand larceny.
