Single vehicle accident on Sliding Hill Road kills Mechanicsville man.

On Saturday, September 19, 2009 at approximately 4:20 p.m. emergency personnel responded to Sliding Hill Road at the I-95 south on-ramp for a single vehicle crash. The driver, and sole occupant of the 2007 Ford Explorer, was pronounced deceased at the scene. The driver has been identified as Robert D. Guido, a 52-year-old man from the 9100 block of Jump Circle in the Mechanicsville area of Hanover County.

Crash Investigators have determined that the 2007 Ford Explorer was traveling east on Sliding Hill Road and struck the speed impact barrier separating Sliding Hill Road and the I-95 on-ramp. The vehicle then overturned and landed in the creek bed below the interchange. While Investigators continue to evaluate all aspects of this incident, speed was a factor.

We ask the community to keep the family and friends of Mr. Guido in their thoughts and prayers as they try to cope with the loss of their loved one.
