Hanover County Sheriff's Office Investigates Suspicious Deaths

At approximately 3:30 p.m. today, the Hanover County Sheriff's Office responded to the 7900 block of Wynbrook Lane for a report of a suspicious death. Upon arrival, deputies discovered a 40-year-old adult male and two 3-year-old females deceased inside of the residence.

At this time, the Sheriff's Office is conducting a death investigation. Investigators are collecting and evaluating evidence in an effort to determine the sequence of events that led up to this tragic incident. Preliminary investigation indicates that there are no suspects at large in this case. Upon making proper notification to the next-of-kin, the deceased's names will be released.

This is truly a tragic incident and our thoughts and prayers are with the families of the deceased. Investigators will continue to work diligently and in cooperation with the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (O.C.M.E.) in an effort to bring this case to a final conclusion.
