Sheriff's Office Seeks Bank Robbery Suspect

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating a robbery that occurred approximately 3:30 p.m. today at the Wachovia Bank at 8111 Mechanicsville Turnpike. No one was injured during the robbery.

The black male suspect, dressed as a woman, approached a teller, indicated he was armed, and demanded money. The suspect left the bank with an undisclosed amount of currency. Currently there is no vehicle description.

The suspect is described as a black male, mid-thirties, approximately 5'7" tall, with a medium build. At the time of the robbery, he was wearing a white long sleeve shirt, long white skirt, black long curly wig, and sunglasses.
