

### Sheriff's Office Seeks Robbery Suspect

At approximately 2:30 p.m. today a teller at the Union First Market Bank, located at 7279 Bell Creek Road in Hanover County, was approached by a white male who presented a threatening note, demanding U.S. currency. No one was injured during the commission of this robbery, but the suspect did obtain an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency.

The suspect is described as a **white male, mid to late 40's, 5'10"-6'1", average weight, clean shaven**, and wearing blue jeans, dark colored sweatshirt, a black baseball style cap with a Nike swoosh on the bill, and sun glasses.

Investigators are currently seeking additional information on a **white 2 door sedan with a distinctive rear spoiler**, pictured below, that was seen in the area immediately before and after the robbery. Additionally Investigators received information that the suspect was travelling north on I-95 and possibly in the area of the Pilot gas station on Route 207 just off Exit 104 in Caroline County. That area was searched for the suspect, with the assistance of Caroline County Sheriff's Office and the Virginia State Police, but unfortunately the suspect was not located.
