On September 5, 2004, the Sheriff's Office responded to a location on Waldrop Lane in Hanover County at the request of the Richmond Police Department. The request was a result of a Richmond Officer discovering an unattended child in a vehicle in the city. The vehicle was registered to the Waldrop Lane address.

Sheriff's deputies responded to this address to check on the welfare of the residents, and through investigation at this location, discovered the body of 41-year-old Doris Hargrove. The Medical Examiners Office determined the cause of death to be multiple stab wounds to the torso. The Sheriff's Office initiated an immediate investigation into this homicide and we are aggressively following leads on this case.

Since that time however, Mrs. Hargrove's husband, Kelvin Lee Hargrove has not been seen. The Sheriff's Office is concerned with Mr. Hargrove's whereabouts and would like to speak with him in relation to this case.

Although no charges have been filed in Hanover for Mrs. Hargrove's murder, the Richmond Police Department has an outstanding felony warrant on file for Kelvin Hargrove for child neglect in regards to the incident in Richmond on September 5th with the unattended child.

Please find attached to this release a photo of Mr. Hargrove. He is a black male, 5'11" tall and weighs 147lbs.
