Investigator David L. Wright earned the Officer of the Month for January 2006. During the month, this investigator obtained a total of twenty-nine warrants and cleared fifteen cases.

During January, the Sheriff's Office received a report of a larceny of two classic Ford Mustangs. Using diligent police work, Investigator Wright was able to develop suspects through visiting and exploring outlets for Mustang parts. With the assistance of the dealers, this officer obtained information and was able to develop a suspect. After extensive interviews with witnesses, the suspect confessed to the larceny and the vintage vehicles were recovered and returned to the owner.

In another case assigned to this investigator, multiple warrants were obtained on three individuals involved in numerous vehicle break-ins in Country Club Hills. Eleven cases were cleared during this investigation and further charges are pending on area juveniles.

Also during January, Investigator Wright conducted an investigation into a shooting and malicious wounding that resulted in the arrest of a suspect. In another case, charges were obtained for forgery, uttering, and impersonating a notary while attempting unauthorized use of a house as collateral for a loan.

Investigator Wright routinely performs his duties with the highest standard of work ethic. He pays meticulous attention to detail, always carries a positive attitude and is a dedicated law enforcement officer. As a result of his activity during the month, he is awarded the prestigious honor as ***OFFICER OF THE MONTH FOR JANUARY 2006***.
