For his many achievements and accomplishments during November, **Deputy Charles Hoakiko** has been selected as the Officer of the Month for the Hanover County Sheriff's Office. During November, this officer received complaints from concerned citizens about possible narcotics activity and loud parties occurring in a Hanover neighborhood. As a result, he initiated over seventy-seven property checks and conducted over twenty-two Park, Walk and Talks. His efforts paid off and resulted in two arrests for drunk in public, two arrests for possession of marijuana and one felony possession with intent to distribute cocaine. In addition, the loud activity has ceased.

Deputy Hoakiko has demonstrated a team oriented approach among his peers assigned to the Midnight Shift of Uniform Patrol and shows a strong motivation every day in the performance of his duties. As a result of his efforts, he is chosen for the prestigious honor as ***Officer of the Month for November 2005.***
