The Hanover County Sheriff's Office is pleased to announce that **Deputy Greg W. Six** has been recognized for his outstanding achievements during the month of September 2006.

During the month of September 2006, Deputy Six provided instruction to the new academy class on emergency vehicle operation, completed the field training of a new Deputy, was involved in the investigation of two traffic fatalities and one serious injury crash, and conducted an investigation that led to the apprehension of the person responsible for a home invasion robbery in Henrico County and a false police report in Hanover County.

Deputy Six was instrumental in the apprehension of a suspect in a home invasion in Henrico where over \$1,400 was taken from the victim. The suspect reported his license plates stolen and with no other evidence Henrico County could not make an arrest. Deputy Six maintained contact with Henrico Police and when all their efforts were exhausted, including a polygraph examination; Deputy Six went forward on his false police report case. During the course of arresting the suspect for filing a false police report, Deputy Six solicited a confession on the robbery and recovered the license plates and the remainder of the cash that was taken in the robbery.

Deputy Six's persistence, excellent interviewing skills, and ability to maintain an effective working relationship with other law enforcement agencies were instrumental in the apprehension of a violent criminal. For his efforts Deputy Six is awarded the prestigious honor of Officer of the Month for October 2006.
