Hanover County Sheriff's Office Investigators obtain charges on two individuals in connection with violent robberies in Hanover County.

Ronald Burruss, an 18-year-old black male and Lamond L. Latney, a 19-year-old black male have been charged in the May 29<sup>th</sup> robbery at the Doswell Market, located at 15145 North Washington Highway. During this incident the clerk, a 42-year-old male, disarmed the suspect (Burruss), who was yielding a knife. In the struggle the clerk received a laceration to his right hand. Burruss and Latney have also been charged in the June 6<sup>th</sup> robbery at the 7-11, located at 10305 Washington Highway. In that robbery, the clerk, a 50-year-old female was shot in the foot.

A combination of witness information, citizen involvement and excellent investigative work led to the arrest of these two individuals. Investigators are continuing to follow up on additional leads and are cooperating with several other surrounding jurisdictions that have had similar robberies.

"We have no tolerance for this type of senseless crime and we will work tirelessly to ensure all such cases are resolved successfully. This is but one example of the fine work conducted by our investigative team," said Sheriff V.S. Cook.
