On July 31, 2005, at approximately 3:36am, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 17000 block of Coatesville Road for a report of a male lying in the roadway. Upon their arrival, deputies located 39-year-old Clinton M. Terrell of Doswell, lying deceased in the southbound lane of Coatesville Road, just south of Annfield Road.

An investigation completed by the Medical Examiner determined that Mr. Terrell was struck by a vehicle and died as a result of the injuries that he sustained.

The death of Mr. Terrell is approaching its first anniversary, and investigators from the Sheriff's Office are requesting assistance from the public with any information that may lead to any witnesses or persons with knowledge as to the events surrounding his death. To date, Sheriff's Investigators have interviewed in excess of sixty people, subpoenaed and interviewed three people through the Multi-jurisdictional Grand Jury, conducted two road checks in the area of the incident, and inspected several vehicles that may have possibly been involved.
