The Hanover County Sheriff's Office is sad to report that a 53-year-old male was killed as a result of a traffic crash.

On Sunday, April 8, 2007 at approximately 9:16 p.m. Sheriff's Deputies responded to the intersection of Washington Highway and Short Cut Lane in North Central Hanover County in reference to a single vehicle accident. The preliminary investigation indicates that a 2003 KIA minivan ran off the right side of the highway and overturned ejecting the driver who was not properly restrained. It is unknown at this time if speed or alcohol were factors of the crash.

The driver, a Richmond resident whose name is being withheld until notification of the next of kin, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office Traffic Safety Unit is continuing the investigation of the crash. We ask that the community keep the family and friends in their thoughts and prayers as they cope with the loss of their loved one.
