The Hanover County Sheriff's Office makes 16 arrests at party attended by underage youths.

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office responded to the 7400-block of Lexington Drive at approximately 3:00 a.m. this morning in reference to a suspicious vehicle. Upon arriving at the scene, Deputies observed a large outdoor party attended by several underage individuals. Their subsequent investigation lead to 13 underage possession of alcohol arrests, 1 drunk in public arrest, 1 concealed weapon arrest, and 1 possession of controlled substance arrest.

Deputies and Investigators from Patrol, Narcotics, and Youth Services assisted in processing this scene and continue to investigate all aspects of this gathering.

"Our agency is committed to aggressively enforcing the underage consumption of alcohol and we will utilize all the resources of the Hanover County Sheriff's Office to effectively curb this disturbing trend," said Colonel V. Stuart Cook.
