Two men charged in Greentop Sporting Goods burglary.

The two men responsible for the June 13, 2008 burglary to Greentop Sporting Goods where 34 handguns were stolen have been identified and arrested.

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office has obtained warrants for burglary, grand larceny, possession of burglary tools and conspiracy on Michael A. Henderson, a 21-year-old black male, of the 1700 block of Peachtree Lane of Bowie, Maryland and Leon E. Waddy, a 21-year-old black male, of the 200 block of Orange Street in SE Washington, D.C., for their involvement in the Greentop Sporting Goods burglary.

Michael Henderson is currently being held in federal detention in Maryland and Waddy is in federal custody in Washington, D.C. Both men will also face additional federal charges related to their actions in this case.

While this is a very positive development in this case, Investigators from the Sheriff's Office and federal authorities are continuing their work in order to collect all the available evidence.

"The quick resolution of this case should serve as an example to the effectiveness of law enforcement that work in a cooperative effort to keep our communities safe. As this investigation continues, I will ensure that all measures are taken to advance this case to a successful prosecution," said Colonel V. Stuart Cook.
