
The Hanover County Sheriff's Office made several arrests on recent residential burglaries in the western area of the County.

Investigators have linked four daytime residential burglaries occurring between December 31, 2008, and January 7, 2009, to four individuals. These burglaries occurred in the 1900 block of Hewlett Road, the 14000 block of Verdon Road, and both the 16000 and 17000 blocks of Goshen Road.

Those arrested are identified as:

Danielle Lee Barker, an 18-year-old female from Ruther Glen, VA, has been charged with three counts of breaking and entering and possession of marijuana.

James Edwin Hall, a 23-year-old male from Milford, VA, has been charged with four counts of breaking and entering, four counts of grand larceny, and one count of conspiracy.

Jesse Allen Heflin, a 26-year-old male from Woodford, VA, has been charged with four counts of breaking and entering, four counts of grand larceny, and one count of conspiracy.

Nichole Elizabeth Monahan, a 27-year-old female from Milford, VA, has been charged with three counts of breaking and entering.
