## **Youths charged with discharging bottle bombs at two Hanover School events**

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office has identified and charged two Hanover County youths in connection with two separate incidents at Mechanicsville area high schools on September 11, 2008, involving small plastic bottles that were used to create bottle bomb devices.

A 16-year-old male and a 15-year-old male, both Hanover County residents, have each been charged with two counts of Manufacture, Possession, and Use of Explosive Materials or Devices and one count of Conspiracy for their involvement in incidents that occurred at Lee-Davis High School and Hanover High School during Junior Varsity Football games last week.

The quick resolution of the case can be attributed to the support of school officials, Hanover Fire & EMS, responding Deputies and Investigators, and in large part the contributions of our citizens.
