Early yesterday morning, the Sheriff's Office responded to the scene of a traffic crash that resulted in the death of a pedestrian.

At 4:44 a.m. on Sunday morning, deputies responded to a call that a pedestrian had been struck by a vehicle on Rt. 360, approximately one half a mile west of Walnut Grove Road.

Preliminary investigation revealed that a 1993 Pontiac sedan was traveling east on Mechanicsville Turnpike in the right lane when a pedestrian crossed Rt. 360 from the median into the path of the oncoming vehicle. The driver of the vehicle immediately ran to a phone to alert authorities and summons aid.

The pedestrian, 41 year old Brian David Conway of the 6000 block of Mechanicsville Turnpike, was declared dead at the scene by responding rescue units.

This tragic accident remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Office Crash Investigation Team.

The Sheriff's Office asks that the community keep their thoughts and prayers with Mr. Conway's friends and family.
