

Hanover County Sheriff's Office seeks robbery suspect

The Hanover County Sheriff's Office needs assistance in identifying the person responsible for robbing the Montpelier Pharmacy, located in the 17000 block of Mountain Road, on February 12, 2009.

At approximately 2:30 p.m., the suspect, described as a white male in his mid-twenties, of average height and weight, wearing a dark blue hooded sweatshirt with white lettering on the front, blue jeans, and purple fleece gloves, approached the pharmacist behind the counter, indicated he was armed, and demanded pharmaceuticals. No one was injured during the commission of this robbery.

The suspect left the store after recovering an undisclosed amount of pain medication. The suspect was seen leaving the area in a tan or gold midsize vehicle with a Virginia license plate *possibly displaying the first three letters of "KIP."*
